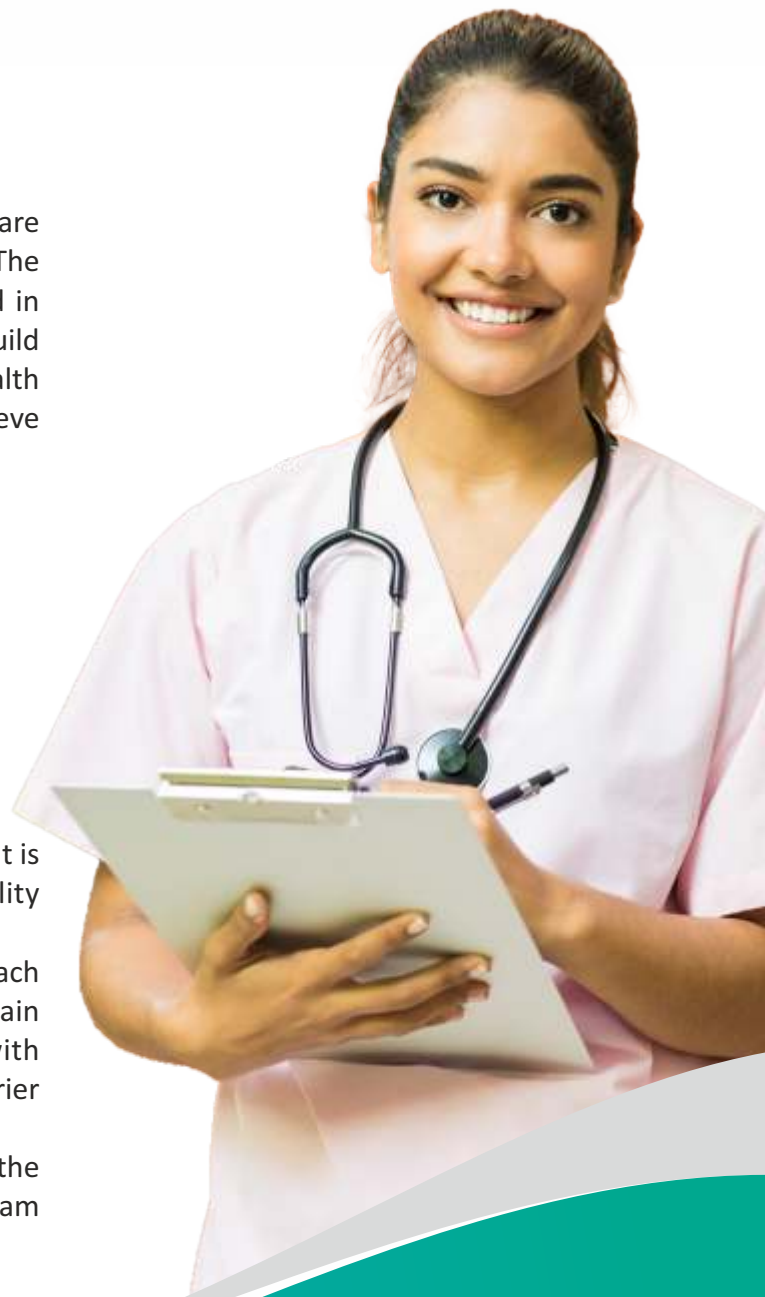
MISSION

Classrooms

Jeevandeep Institute of Nursing & Paramedical Sciences has a magnificent building surrounded with good environment where the students get fresh air and nature. The building has a number of classrooms, which are well spacious, sound proof with modern technological facilities to enrich the teaching. Nursing Foundation Lab

This lab is well-equipped with 10 beds & set of all items needed for nursing procedure to provide comprehensive nursing care to the patients admitted in the hospitals, students will be given preliminary training in patient care at the college laboratory.





Community Health Nursing & Nutrition Lab

This lab is well-equipped with set of all items needed for nursing practice to provide comprehensive nursing care to the clients in community, students will be given preliminary training in clients care at the college laboratory.





Advance Nursing Skill Lab

The aim of this Lab is to provide best practical knowledge in advance nursing procedures under the guidance of experts in subjects.





Audio-Visual Aids Room

Our AV-Aids Rooms are fully equipped with various electronic devices for the effective teaching & learning such as LCD projectors, over head projectors, T.V, V.C.R, C.D. Player, Tape recorder etc. We also have various teaching materials & demonstration materials, which helps in teaching and practical classes.





Library

The Library in Jeevandeep Institute of Nursing & Paramedical Sciences is having adequate number of books for students and lectures referral. Also we have plenty of journals for students' reference. Which help them to enhance their Knowledge in various areas of health care profession. Our library is managed by a qualified full time available librarian to guide students in various aspects.

E-Library

Transport

The student are privileged to have transport facilities which enable them to reach all the areas of clinical exposures. The faculty & students also have pickup & drop facilities between the institute and hostel.

In all the semesters, the clinical and observational visits of students to various organizations are arranged as per the requirements prescribed by Atal Bihari Vajpayee Medical University, Lucknow and Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi.

Hostel

Well furnished hostel and mess facilities are provided for the students within the campus. Application form for admission to hostel can be obtained from the institute office.





Extra Curricular

Participating in sports, music clubs celebrating International Nursing Day and other activities can help students to improve their organizational skills while building a solid network of future peers and employers.

Sports & Game

Participation in sports are known to have many benefits for the students. It has been correlated with positive developmental indicators, including improved self-esteem, self confidence, cognitive development, social development, goal attainment, problem-solving and academic performance.

Students are permitted and encouraged for participating in various sports events after the study hours. The institute has indoor game facilities in our hostel to get some relief from in-house study of our hostel students. Such as Carrum, Chess, Badminton, etc.



Leadership Skill Building

Nurses are often encouraged to pursue leadership roles because of their strong clinical expertise. While frontline nursing roles certainly require specific leadership skills, formal leadership roles in nursing call for additional knowledge and competencies. The art and science of nursing leadership hinges on authenticity, accessibility, communication, relationship building, collaboration, transparency, recognition, accountability, and trust.

Leadership is a skill build over time and through rigorous mentoring. The institute will offer opportunities to develop leadership skill to make the students ready for practical life situations.

Rules & Regulations of the Institute

Jeevandeep Institute of Nursing & Paramedical Sciences prepares its trainees to become exemplary citizens by adhering to code of ethics and professional conduct at all times in fulfilling personal and professional obligations.

- Every student admitted to the ANM, GNM & B.Sc. (Nursing) course shall have to follow rules and regulations of the institute.
- All decisions taken by the management are final.
- Students must assemble in the college campus for the prayer sharp at 9.45 am every day. Students are required to be regular and punctual for the class. Students are expected to be in the class at least 5 minutes before the commencement of the period.
- Students should maintain perfect order and strict silence inside the lecture hall.
- Movement outside the class room in between lectures should be minimum and for valid reasons only.
- Loitering around the corridors during classes and attending other classes are not allowed.
- Students should maintain silence in the class, library, reading room and in the corridors.
- Students should make every effort to take care of the college and hospital property and help in maintaining the same. They should not write on the black board, scribble on tables, chairs, walls etc.
- Students are not allowed to come directly to the Principal office without permission of the class coordinator, until there is any emergency.
- If the students have any problem, they should inform the class representative and the class representative will intimate it to the class coordinators. If the problem is not solved at the class coordinator's level, then the class students should bypass the above mentioned channels. Exceptions are allowed only if the problem is utmost urgent/serious.
- A student nurse is not allowed to receive gift or gratuity of any sort at any time from the patients of the hospital or their relatives.
- Students are required to maintain ethical and professional standards in behavior both inside and outside the college, hospital, hostel and community premises.
- Each student is responsible for the proper handling and safe custody of any apparatus or equipment that she may be using in different nursing labs. Misuse or negligence will result in replacement of the particular item by the candidate. Any willful damage done to the property of the college or hospital will be treated as breach of discipline.

- Students are forbidden to communicate with any person outside the authority without permission from the Office of the Principal.
- Any student who damages the reputation of the institute in any way is liable to be expelled. If any student discontinues the course, she/he shall clear all dues before leaving the college. If she/he fails to pay, her original certificates will be retained and will be returned once the dues are cleared by the student.
- Violating the rules of institute / hostel will be dealt with seriously by the college authorities and if necessary dismissal from the college may be considered

depending upon the seriousness of the violation.

- The institute provides transport facilities for students field work but whenever this is not feasible, the student will have to use public transport at her own expenses.
- Rules are subject to change from time to time.

Rules & Regulations of the Hostel

It is compulsory to stay in the hostel during the training period.

- Rooms should be kept clean and tidy. Students are fully responsible for any loss / damage of furniture / fixture allotted to them and fines will be imposed accordingly.
- Proper locks should be used for cupboards and boxes. Jewellery and expensive items are not permitted in the rooms and the school authority shall not be responsible for any theft / loss or damage of students' personal belongings in any manner whatsoever.
- Wastage of water and electricity will lead to strong disciplinary action.
- Students should come to the Hostel / Canteen in proper attire.
- In case of sickness, students should report to the Principal / Warden.
- No electrical cooking or heating appliances will be allowed in hostel room.
- Visitors are not allowed to go in the students room.
- In case of gross misconduct, student may be expelled from the Nursing college & Hostel. In such case, fees paid shall not be refunded.
- Management is fully authorized to effect any change in rules and regulations at any time.
- Hostel rules as declared by the management will be binding on the hostel residents from the date and time of allotment of the hostel seat.
- Ragging is strictly prohibited and will result in immediate expulsion of the student from the institute.
- There should be 2 nights stay at home in a month : with going home in between students should get prior permission from Management / Principal.



ANTI RAGGING

Ragging in Jeevandeep Institute of Nursing & Paramedical Science in any form is banned inside and outside the campus. Strict action is taken against persons flouting this rule; no leniency is shown. Suspension and/or withdrawal from the hostel/ institute is the first action against the offender. The Supreme Court of India has also defined ragging as a criminal offense.

Any conduct by a student, whether by words spoken or written or by an act which includes physical abuse, lewd acts, teasing & rude treatment, indulging in rowdy, undisciplined and obscene activities which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, undue hardship, physical or psychological harm or mental trauma or raise apprehension or fear in a fresher / junior student or other students or forcing a student to do any act which such a student is not willing to do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of embarrassment or danger to a student's life or adversely affect the physique or psyche of a fresher or a junior student.
